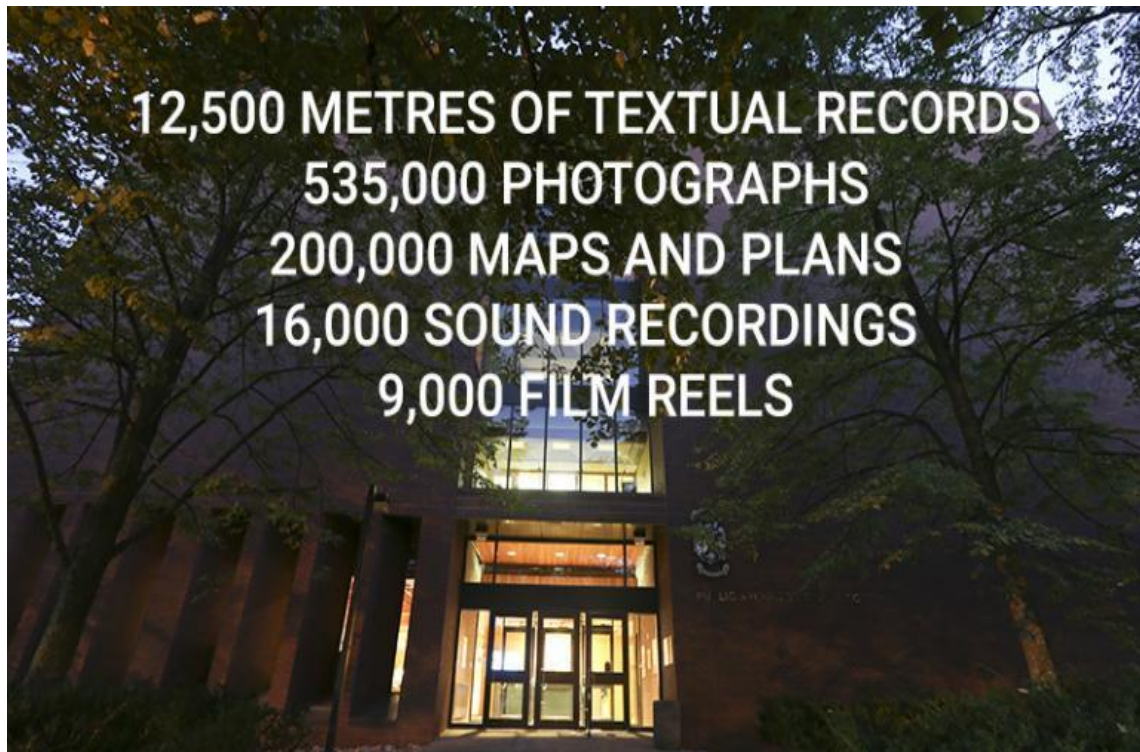

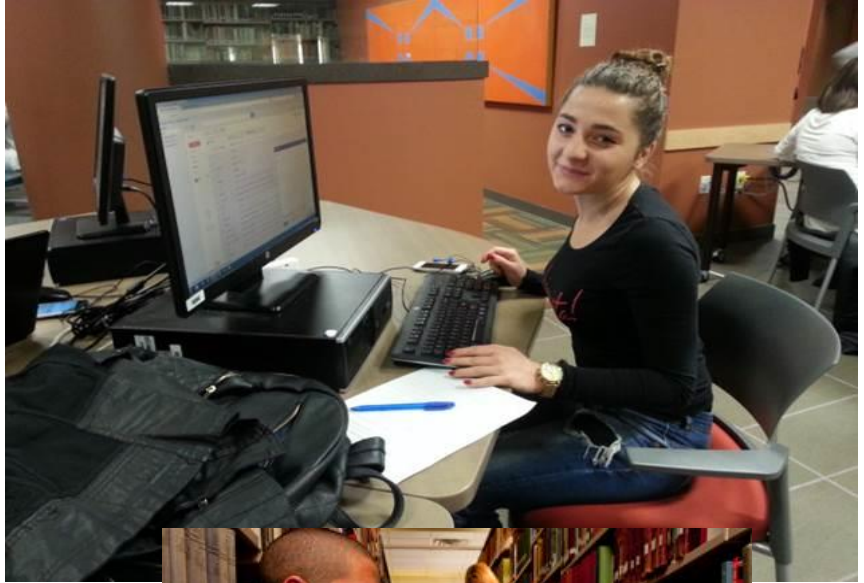

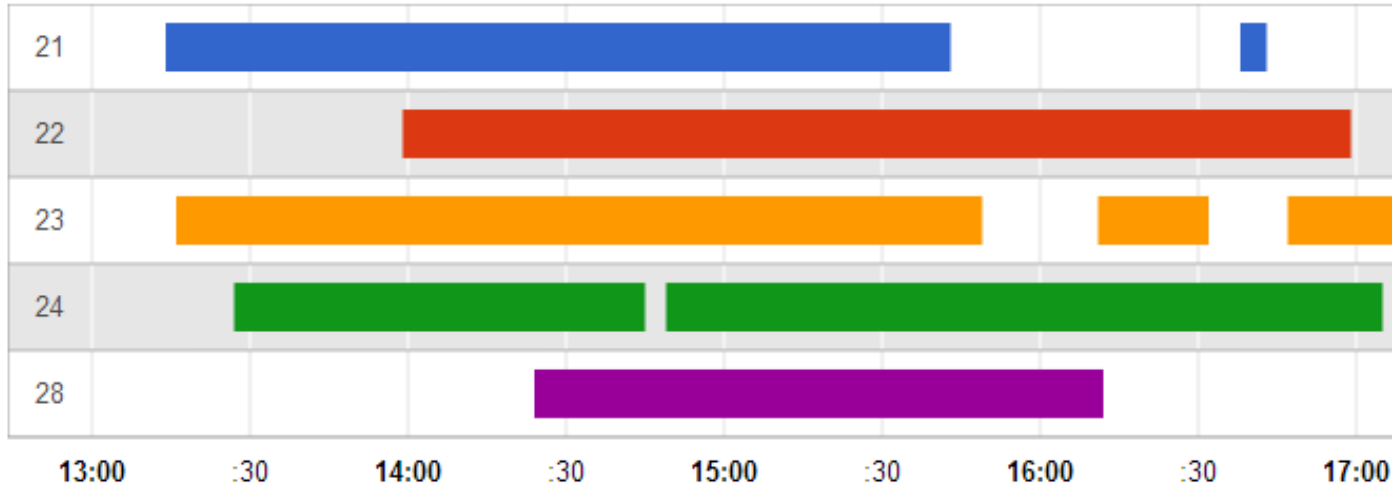




- Support teaching, learning and research across Nova Scotia
